

Ottawa Area Inter-OHT Support Process

On May 11th 2023, the Ministry of Health and Ontario Health released their call [for Expressions of Interest for expanding and enhancing interprofessional primary care teams](#). Please note that being part of an Ontario Health Team (OHT), or having OHT endorsement is not mandatory, but it is encouraged.

To respond to this opportunity for OHT support, we have put in place a common process to review and provide letters in support for your proposals. If your organization would like to confirm OHT alignment and support for your submission, please note the following process:

- ✓ Submit your request and your completed EOI by email to your OHT. You will receive a response within 3 business days (all requests for OHT support must be received no later than June 13, 2023 to meet the submission deadline).

- ✓ OHT will review the request for support to ensure it reflects and is aligned with the vision and principles of the OHT.
- ✓ The request will be documented to help identify system-level themes and gaps.
- ✓ OHT leadership will review and provide signed letters of support within 3 business days of the request.
